



Gerald Pearsall Memorial Travel Award

The Gerald Pearsall Memorial Travel Award program recognizes the tremendous academic and career benefits of learning about other cultures. In partnership with Oakland University, the award of up to \$250 is designed to support students traveling domestically or internationally to enhance their understanding of the world and its many peoples by paying for their accommodations in hostels during their travel.

Scholarship Criteria

Students must meet the following minimum criteria to be considered:

1. Be an undergraduate with a minimum of 16 credit hours at the time of departure.
2. Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.8 or higher.
3. Submit a scholarship application, including 1.) an itinerary and budget for travel with hostel stay locations and prices included, 2.) a paragraph about the purpose of your travel, 3.) a copy of your resume, and 4.) a copy of your transcript.
4. Provide one letter of recommendation from an Oakland University faculty member supporting your proposed travel.
